Announcement of the New Port Amalgamation

On January 1st 2008, the much-anticipated amalgamation of the lower mainland Port Authorities came into effect. The amalgamated port authority consists of the three ports formerly known as the Fraser River Port Authority, the Vancouver Port Authority, and the North Fraser Port Authority. This amalgamation was met with great support from both the Provincial and Federal government and is seen as a key action in the Federal governments "Asia-Pacific Gateway Corridor Initiative."
